

TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS:

Taxis are an option (~\$55 one way). The public transportation system in Seattle is great and affordable (~\$6 one way)!

If taking public transportation to get to University of Washington or hotels from Seattle/Tacoma (SEATAC) airport:

Rail/bus directions:

Walk to SEATAC Link Light Rail station at North end of airport via parking garage

-purchase ticket for \$3.00 to University St. Station from automated Kiosk (machine accepts cards and cash)

Go up escalators to board train LOCAL to Link to Seattle

-press red buttons next to doors on train in order for them to open.

GET OFF at University St. Station to transfer to bus- walk north on same platform (stay underground, the same direction as the train you were on) to the bus bays (C) at north end of station. Signs will demark bus route numbers.

Look for sign demarking bus # 71, 72, 73, etc.

You will need EXACT CHANGE (cash only, recommend getting cash before leaving airport) to board at the University St. station). The cost is \$2.25/2.50 depending on the time of day.

BOARD any of the local or express routes of these buses.

#71 Wedgwood

#72 toward Lake City University

#73 toward University District

TO GET TO HOTELS FROM AIRPORT:

GET OFF: between 42nd and 43rd and University Ave. to go the Watertown hotel/University Inn

Watertown Hotel and University Inn: walk north, direction bus was moving, uphill on University Ave, take 1st/immediate left (west) on 43rd (toward Flowers restaurant), continue on 43rd Ave NE 4 blocks (~0.25 miles) until turning left (south, downhill) on Roosevelt Way NE.

-Watertown Hotel is on corner of 43rd and Roosevelt Way NE

-University Inn is on corner of 42nd and Roosevelt Way NE

TO GET DIRECTLY TO WORKSHOP FROM AIRPORT:

GET OFF: at Campus Parkway NE and Brooklyn Ave NE stop to get to campus/Ocean Sciences Building

- head downhill, south, toward the water on Brooklyn Ave toward NE Boat St. Take left on NE Boat St., walk past Agua Verde Café on right close and 3 way stop. Ocean Sciences Building will be first building on left (on street side away from the water) past this intersection.

TO WALK TO WORKSHOP FROM HOTELS:

-walk south, downhill on Roosevelt Way NE ~3 blocks, take left (east) on NE Campus Parkway, continue for one block then take right (south, toward water, downhill) on Brooklyn Ave. and walk until T at the water. Take left at T on NE Boat St. /Columbia Rd, bear right near Agua Verde café to stay near the water. Once past the café and a 3 way intersection, Ocean Sciences Building will be first building on left (on street side away from the water) past this intersection.
