Authorization for U.S. Marine Scientific Research Vessel NOAA FAIRWEATHER (June 11<sup>th</sup> to July 10<sup>th</sup> 2013)

I am pleased to advise that the Government of Canada grants its consent to the request for the U.S. Research Vessel NOAA FAIRWEATHER to undertake marine scientific research in areas under the national jurisdiction of Canada during the above mentioned dates.

Please note the following Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) marine reporting requirements. Foreign research vessels that enter Canadian territorial waters (within the 12 nautical mile zone) are required to report to the nearest CBSA office designated for the clearance of vessels. Reporting to the local CBSA office may be performed by telephone communication unless requested by the officer to proceed to the nearest CBSA office for examination.
