November 17 - December 12, 2017

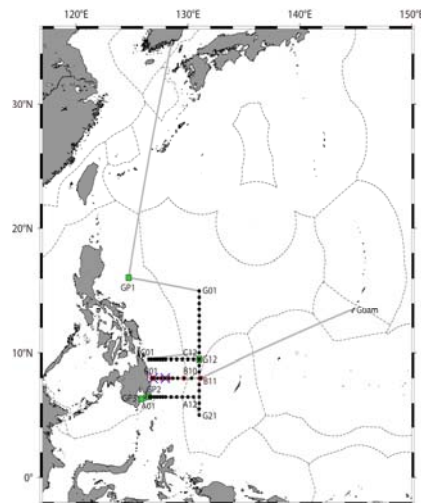
Warm season, 2018, 2019
